# **2023-2024 LAWN SERVICE**



- ★ The Contractor will be responsible for lawn maintenance including mowing, edging and spraying for weeds.
- ★ The Contractor will be responsible for removal of rubbish from mowing areas; all nonirrigated areas will be mowed and edged. Lawns must be power trimmed around and along all walkways, lamp posts, signposts, fences, shrubs, flower beds, and any other obstructions.
- ★ Walkways must be swept or blown clean of debris and/or grass clippings, and any debris left on buildings because of mowing or trimming must be cleaned off.
- ★ Maintain the lawns at the properties described within terms and conditions specified below and in the Service Contract that will be required.

## Scope of Work for Lawn Care for all MHA properties include:

- All grass to be cut bi-weekly or on as needed basis
- String trim / weed whack around all buildings, sidewalks and whatever cannot be moved in yards when moving property.
- Walkways must be swept or blown clean of debris and/or grass clippings, and any debris left on buildings because of mowing or trimming must be cleaned off.
- Edging/cutting of all sidewalks once in spring and end of summer/fall
- (Optional Pricing) Once a year fall cleanup, Final cut, string trim and remove leaves from properties. (Shrub and brushes can be done at same time)

## Lawn Care Routine includes:

- Mow Apartment Towers, 300 N. 5<sup>th</sup> St. (Swept or blown clean walkways and structures)
- Mow Carlson Plaza, 425 Pierre St. (Swept or blown clean walkways and structures.)
- Mow Hudson Circle, Anderson Ave. & Hudson Circle. (Swept or blown clean walkways and structures. Spray for weeds in sidewalks and around buildings, trim edges and around buildings on a weekly / biweekly schedule.)
- Mow Baehr Place, Claflin Ave. & Baehr Place. (Swept or blown clean walkways and structures)
- Mow Pottawatomie Court, 104 & Pottawatomie Ct. (Swept or blown clean walkways and structures.)
- Mow Flint Hills Place, NW corner Manhattan Ave. & Flint Hills Place. (Swept or blown clean walkways and structures)

#### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The contractor and the Housing Authority will negotiate the number of lawn cuttings and trimmings per month.
- 2. The Manhattan Housing Authority may request special services such as fertilization, spraying for weeds, cleaning of gutters, trimming shrubs, laying mulch, clearing fence lines, etc. Contractor should provide recommendations and estimated costs to the Housing Authority for performance of these services, as necessary.
- 3. The contractor shall furnish all necessary labor, materials, tools, equipment, and transportation necessary for performance of work.
- 4. The contractor must show Proof of Insurance at the time of contract signing and as renewals or changes in coverage occur. The contractor shall be responsible for all damage to persons or property that occurs because of the contractor's fault or negligence. The contractor shall take proper safety and health precautions to protect workers, property of others and the public.
- 5. The contractor shall submit all requests for payment to the Housing Authority each month.
- 6. The Contractor understands that the Manhattan Housing Authority is the Management Agent for Flint Hills Place property (FHI Apartments, LP). As such, while the property is included in this procurement, a separate contract will be executed for this property, and it should be billed separately from the Owned properties (Baehr Place, Hudson Circle, Pottawatomie Court, Carlson Plaza, and Apartment Towers).

#### **SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

The Manhattan Housing Authority will have the option to request the contractor perform additional work outside the scope of the specifications and conditions listed above that are within the contractor's profession, at an additional charge as negotiated and agreed upon in writing by both parties.

These specifications and conditions will become a part of the Service Contract for each site placed under contract for lawn care and maintenance.

MHA reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or to waive any informalities in the bidding. The Manhattan Housing Authority will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, gender, sexual orientation, status, disability familial status, or age.
